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Figure 1. Measures That Matter Phases of Quality Measure Development chart describes the phases of development of the higher value primary care measures.

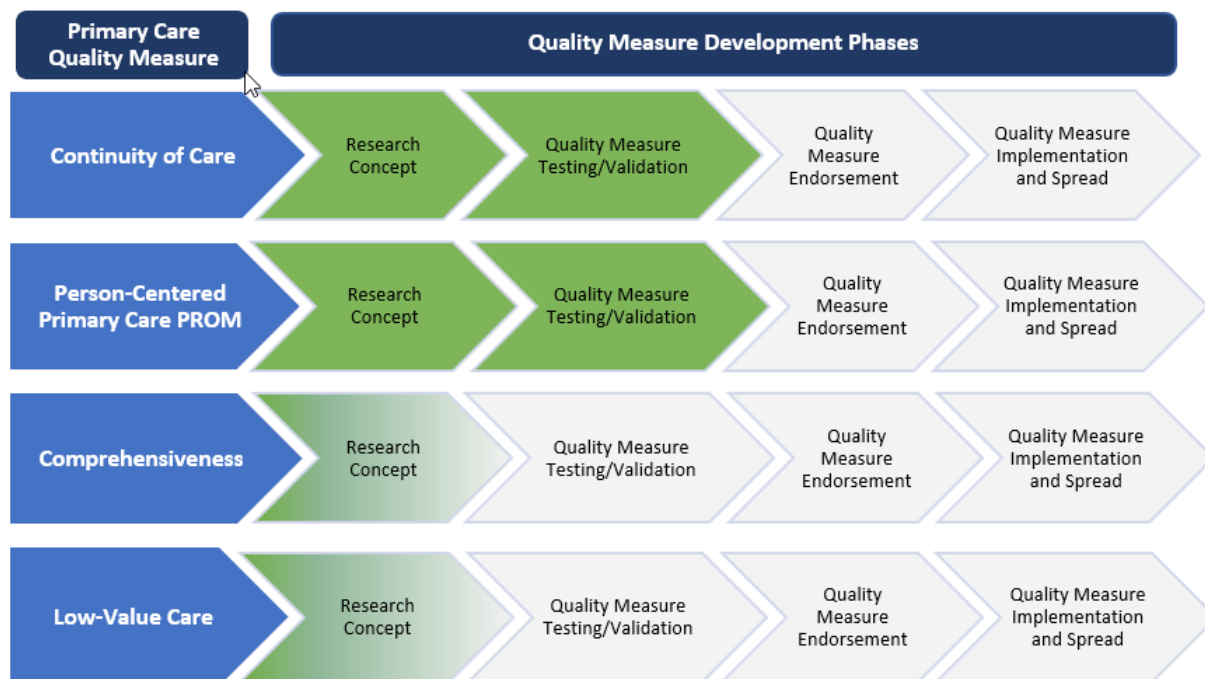


Figure 2. Quality Measure Endorsement Programs and evaluation criteria.
