
Evaluation of a Program to Support Medication for Opioid Use Disorder in Primary Care Practices

Results from an intervention to increase clinic capacity for offering medication for opioid use disorder (MOUD) in 15 Colorado primary care practices



The mean number of active buprenorphine prescriptions per clinic increased from 2.1 in the 3 months preceding the intervention (baseline) to 11.3 at 13 months (*P* < .001).
