Supplemental Appendix. Scoring Key for the Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test-Consumption (AUDIT-C)	
Question	Points
1. How often do you have a drink containing alcohol	
Never	0
Monthly or less	1
2 to 4 times a month	2
2 to 3 times a week	3
4 or more times a week	4
2. How many drinks containing alcohol do you have on a typical day when you are drinking?	
I don't drink	0
1 or 2	0
3 or 4	1
5 or 6	2
7 to 9	3
10 or more	4
3. How often do you have 6 or more drinks on 1 occasion?	
Never	0
Less than monthly	1
Monthly	2
Weekly	3
Daily or almost daily	4

Note: AUDIT-C score is the sum of the scores from the 3 questions.
