PI Activity - Identify a Problem or Opportunity

The first step in the performance improvement process involves identifying a problem or opportunity to address within your practice. You may already have something in mind to improve upon in your practice or you may need decide on what you want to work on. When deciding on something to work on review the available measures below to know whether or not you can measure the effects of the improvement you decide to implement.

Once you have decided your objective for improvement, you can choose below the measures you wish to monitor performance. You are required to select a minimum of one (1) measure from the below listed measures. For your convenience, you may select one measure group from the left and appropriate individual measures you wish to monitor in your performance improvement.

Once you have selected the measure you would like to include in your performance improvement, click the 'Next' button.
