What type of content are you submitting?	<p>Original research, open research data, practice innovations, persuasive essays with long-term relevance to primary care.</p> <p>(Please be aware that most COVID-19 manuscripts submitted to <i>Annals of Family Medicine</i> at this time will not be published in the journal. Submitting to the journal simultaneously with the online preprint collection or Family Medicine blog will likely also slow down our consideration.)</p>	Original research, open research data, practice innovation, and insight that will benefit family medicine practitioners immediately and throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.	Personal reflections, best practices, resources, and lessons learned from the front lines (that can generate discussion helpful to clinicians in practice.)
What's the time to publish?	<p>- 3 to 6 months, if accepted for journal publication.</p> <p>- 1-2 weeks if accepted for COVID-19 preprint collection.</p>	1-2 weeks	3 days-1 week
Word counts	Limit 2500 words	No limit	Recommend at least 300 words
Rough acceptance rate	@ 10%	@ 25%	@ 40%

What is the review process?	Annals Editor, Associate Editor, or Editorial Board member reads COVID-19-related manuscript and decides on immediate relevance/ importance to primary care. If yes, the manuscript will be posted as a preprint article and sent out for peer review.	Annals Editor, Associate Editor, or Editorial Board member reads manuscript and decides on immediate relevance/ importance to primary care. If yes, author's permission to post on preprint server is requested.	Community of editors with expertise/experience in primary care will review COVID-19-related writing for relevance/importance to primary care. If interested, blog editors will work with authors to publish to the blog quickly.
Can I put this on my CV?	Yes, if accepted for publication in <i>Annals of Family Medicine</i> .	No. COVID-19 Collection papers are not considered to be published. Rather, they are <i>posted</i> with other non-peer-reviewed contributions of similar urgency. The Collection is similar to a preprint server.	No
Will my MS have a DOI?	Yes	No, but it will have a pervasive URL and permanent linkable handle in UM's institutional repository, Deep Blue .	No
Submission format	Microsoft Word doc. Please include abstract and keywords.	Microsoft Word doc. Please include abstract and keywords.	Medium post draft, Google Doc link, Microsoft Word doc
